

**REGULATIONS OF THE PILESGROVE CONVENIENCE STATION**

**HOURS: WEDNESDAY & FRIDAY 10 A.M. TO 6 P.M.**  
**TUESDAY & SATURDAY 9 A.M. TO 5 P.M.**  
**CLOSED SUNDAY, MONDAY & THURSDAY**

***THE CONVENIENCE CENTER IS ALSO CLOSED ON  
TOWNSHIP DESIGNATED HOLIDAYS***

**RECYCLABLE AND NON-RECYCLABLE ITEMS**

***ALL COMMERCIAL, INSTITUTIONAL, AND FARM BUSINESSES  
MUST RECYCLE ALONG WITH ALL RESIDENTIAL HOUSEHOLDS***

**THE CONVENIENCE STATION IS FOR THE USE OF  
PERMANENT RESIDENTS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PILESGROVE  
ON AN INDIVIDUAL HOUSEHOLD BASIS. A PERMIT IS REQUIRED TO  
USE THE CONVENIENCE STATION.**

**COMMERCIAL, FARM, AND INSTITUTIONAL ESTABLISHMENTS  
LOCATED WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY  
MAY USE THE CONVENIENCE STATION  
FOR RECYCLABLES ONLY.**

**NON-RECYCLABLES (TRASH) OF THESE ESTABLISHMENTS  
ARE NOT ACCEPTED  
AND MUST BE DISPOSED OF AT THE  
SALEM COUNTY UTILITIES AUTHORITY (SCUA)  
*THE SCUA CHARGES ALL USERS PER POUND FOR DISPOSAL***

Trash will be randomly inspected for compliance and  
MUST be bagged (50 lbs or less) to avoid spillage.

Trees and limbs will be chipped at the Convenience Station  
and the chips will be available to residents at **no cost**  
during regular Convenience Station hours.

Please see reverse for definition of trees and limbs.

**ALL POSTED SAFETY REGULATIONS ON SITE

# TRASH AND RECYCLING REQUIREMENTS

- 1) **NO TRASH Or RECYCLABLES** Generated **OUTSIDE** Of **PILESGROVE** Will Be **ACCEPTED**.
- 2) **You MUST** obtain a permit from the Township Clerk's office to use the Convenience Station.
- 3) **Garbage** and non-recyclable trash are required to be bagged and tied and **Shall Not** exceed **Fifty (50) lbs.**
- 4) **NO** animal waste accepted.
- 5) **NO Asbestos** products are accepted. **Asbestos** products **Must Be Taken** to the SCUA facility only.
- 6) **NO Construction Debris Accepted.** Debris from "contracted" projects requiring a construction and/or demolition permit must be disposed of at the SCUA or approved recycling facility by a licensed hauler. \*Residents may dispose of construction/demolition debris at the SCUA (**Wed. & Sat., 8 A.M. to 3 P.M.**) or an approved recycling facility. The SCUA charges all users per pound for disposal.
- 7) **Fees** are charged by the Township for the disposal of certain items. The **Fee Schedule** is posted at the Convenience Station.

## REQUIREMENTS PERTAINING TO THE SEPARATION OF RECYCLABLES

### THE ITEMS LISTED IN THIS SECTION CAN BE PLACE IN THE SAME CONTAINER

#### PLASTICS (CLEAN, ONLY)

Recycling symbol located on bottom of container

- 1) Rinse residue from containers
- 2) Discard plastic lids/metal rings
- 3) Crushing recommended

Recycle following 4 items, only:

Detergent Bottles  
Soda Bottles  
Milk & Water Containers



#### ALUMINUM

- 1) Crushing recommended

#### GLASS (ALL COLORS – CLEAN ONLY)

- 1) Discard lids & caps
- 2) Rinse residue from bottle

Including:

Clear bottles  
Brown bottles  
Green bottles

Excluding:

Blue & flat glass  
Mirrors  
Light bulbs  
Window glass, ceramics

#### STEEL CONTAINERS

- 1) Rinse thoroughly
- 2) Crushing recommended

Including:

Steel, tin, or other metal beverage or food cans (soup, vegetable, etc.). All metal containers that react to a magnet.

### THESE ITEMS MUST BE SEPARATED

#### CARDBOARD (CLEAN, ONLY)

Including:

Corrugated  
Chipboard, i.e.  
cereal, macaroni,  
spaghetti, etc.  
(remove liner)  
"Brown" Bags & Paper

Excluding:

Wax Coated  
Contaminated cardboard, i.e.  
with food, pesticides, etc.

#### WASTEPAPER (CLEAN ONLY)

Including:

Newspaper  
Magazines  
Stationary  
High-grade office paper  
Envelopes

Excluding:

Wrapping paper  
Hard bound books

#### METAL

Including:

All products made of metal (exclusive of aluminum)  
including washers, dryers, refrigerators,  
Stoves, hot water heaters, tire rims, springs,  
bicycles, scrap metal, and air conditioners.

**THERE IS A CHARGE FOR CERTAIN METAL ITEMS  
FEE SCHEDULE POSTED AT CONVENIENCE STATION**

#### YARD WASTE

Residential on-site composting of leaves, grass  
clippings & planting debris is required by  
Township Ordinance.

Limbs & branches to be chipped must be  
6" or less in diameter.

Including:

Tree branches & limbs

Excluding:

Vines, briars, leaves,  
grass clippings, stumps  
land clearing debris

#### MOTOR OIL

Including:

Engine, transmission & hydraulic oil

Excluding:

Anti-freeze

**Very small quantities of building rubble (clean only) will be accepted at the Township Convenience Station. All other construction, demolition and remodeling debris must be disposed of at the Salem County Utilities Authority. The SCUA charges all users per pound for disposal.**
